The new release of Integration Point GTM includes updates to:

- **Integration Point FTZ** – provides zone operators with robust functionality to assist with inventory tracking, inventory reconciliation, e214 filings, and enhanced reporting capabilities for FTZ users including zone-to-zone shipments, product history by lot, and expanded weekly reconciliation report that will reconcile actual shipments to projected estimates at various levels.
