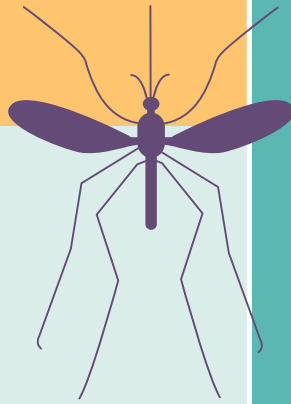

A major focus of the 2017 updates is on environmental and social responsibility chapters.

For instance, did you know that ½ of the world's population is at risk for malaria? The 2017 HS will include detailed information for several categories of products used as anti-malarial commodities.



Along with the 233 amendments, the WCO has published three complimentary amendments

Alignment of subheadings 6304.20 and new subheading note 1 to chapter 63 (Other made up textile articles; sets; worn clothing and worn textile articles; rags)

Replacement of several references to 5-digit codes in certain sub-headings of **03.02** and **03.03** (Fish and crustaceans, molluscs and other aquatic invertebrates)

Further amend in respect of heading **44.01** and certain subheads in **Chapter 44** (Wood and articles made of wood)

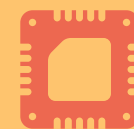
